

This step-by-step guide will help you access the online resource, KUDOS, which is a Careers programme designed to help young people with career choices.



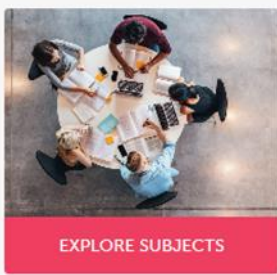



Use the easy Navigation Bar to quickly access different features of Kudos.

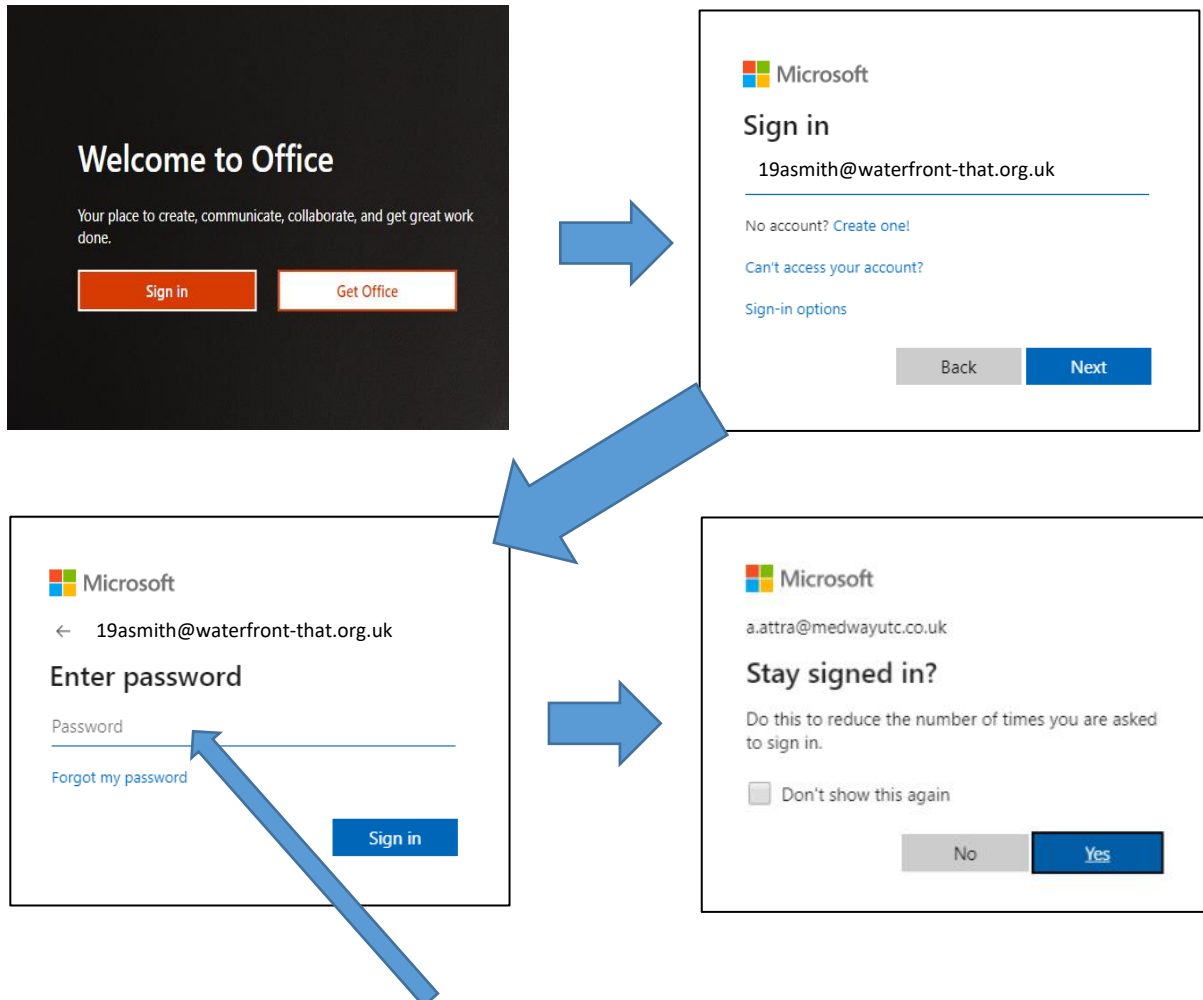
The "LEARNING" section allows you to access information about college and university courses that are available.

The "WORKING" section allows you to access information about different careers and industries as well as information about Apprenticeships and current Job Vacancies.

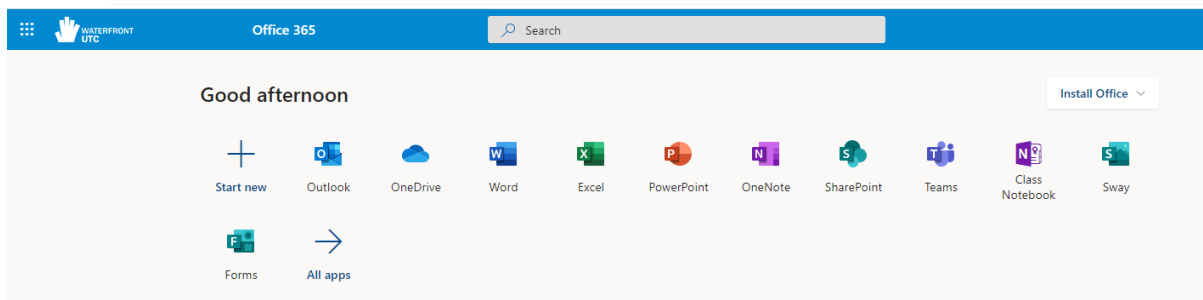
The "ME" section allows you to update your profile and retake any assessments if your interests and focus change over time. You can also use this section to create documents such as CVs.

Go to www.office.com



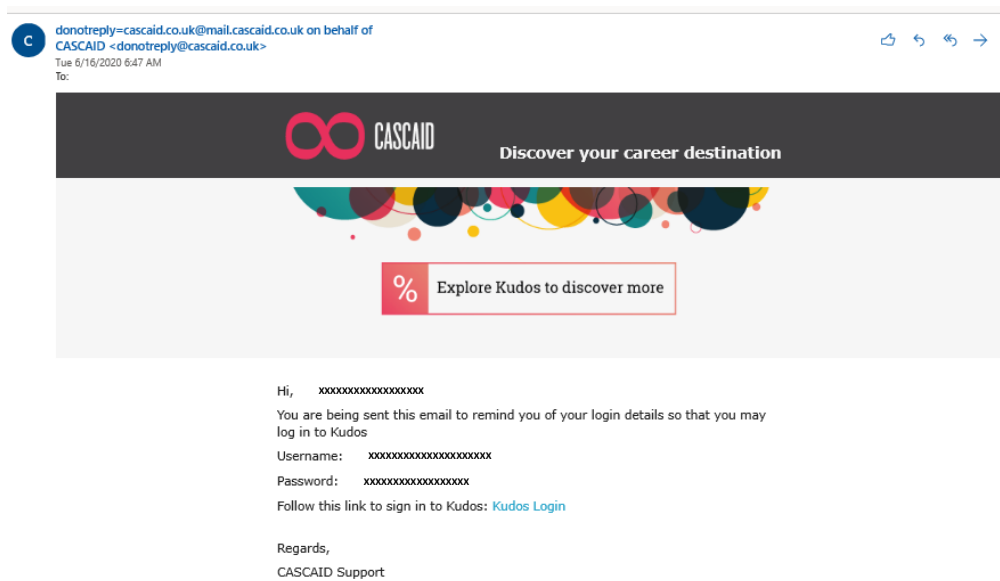
The password you enter here is the password you use to access the school network when in school NOT the Kudos password you have just created.



Once logged in, you will have access to the Office 365 suite software which includes Word, Excel, PowerPoint etc.

In order to access your email click in the Outlook icon.

You will have received 2 emails from Cascaid. The first will be a reminder of your log in details.



The second email will be a verification email. You will need click the link in this email to verify your email address.
